

A Few Rules and Policies At Mountain Meadows Lodge:

- Please be respectful of the lodge property.
- Alcoholic beverages (not purchased on premises) and Fireworks are NOT permitted on the Property. The State of Vermont requires that the Lodge purchase all alcohol consumed on premises from a State Agency. This is a condition of their license. They will confiscate any alcohol not purchased on their property. Please be courteous and sensitive of this issue.
- Anyone who smokes is welcome to do so, on the grounds. The buildings, including balconies are no smoking areas. We strongly adhere to this law and must impose a \$100 penalty fee to anyone breaking it for laundering fees.
