

WELCOME TO VERMONT!

We are so happy you are able to celebrate our wedding with us. We hope you love Vermont as much as we do and have a wonderful, relaxing weekend. This letter should provide you with the information you need for the weekend. If you need more information on anything, please see any of the inn keepers where you are staying.

The Wedding

The wedding will take place at 4:00 on Saturday. Shuttles will be provided for guests both to and from the wedding. The shuttle will be leaving the Snowed Inn at 3:15 for Mountain Meadows. The shuttle will be leaving the Greenbrier at 3:35. Please be outside your inn or in the lobby 10 minutes prior to the shuttle leaving time. Shuttle services will be provided in the evening beginning at 9:00 with the last shuttle leaving Mountain Meadows at 1:00 am. If you choose to drive yourself to the wedding, there is a designated parking area across the street from Mountain Meadows.

Things To Do

There are a lot of different activities going on at Mountain Meadows and in the surrounding areas this weekend that we would like to share with you.

Friday evening there is a casual get-together and bonfire at Mountain Meadows beginning at 7:30. Cash bar will be available as will S'mores, Meghan's favorite treat.

Everyone is welcome to spend the day at Mountain Meadows on Saturday. There are many activities available including a pool, volleyball court, hot tub, hiking trails, lawn games, and boats for the lake. We ask that you depart Mountain Meadows by 2:30 on Saturday in order for the staff to be able to set-up for the wedding.

Saturday morning there is a hike to a nearby waterfall from 7:00-8:15. You need to sign up with Bill or Anne at Mountain Meadows by Friday evening if you are interested. There is always hiking on your own as well. Mountain Meadows and the Greenbrier Inn are both located on the Appalachian Trail and the Long Trail is also nearby, as are Killington and Pico Peak.

In downtown Rutland on Saturday morning, the weekly Farmer's Market is open from 10:00-2:00 and is located in Depot Park (next to Wal-Mart on Merchant's Row). The Farmer's market has great food, local produce and beautiful crafts.

Saturday morning is the annual *Art In The Park Festival*, which is an amazing outdoor craft show with live music and great food. *Art In The Park* is located at the intersection of Route 7 and West Street. It is Meghan's favorite event of the year and you will likely see her there. Be sure to sample (or buy) some fudge.

Pico Mountain has an adventure park with alpine slides, rock walls and gondola rides.

The Long Trail Brewery is located about 10 minutes east of Mountain Meadows on Rte 4. The Otter Creek Brewery is about an hour from Mountain Meadows, heading north on Rte 7 towards Middlebury. Long Trail serves food; Otter Creek has the better tour. Who has the better beer is up for debate.
